IMPORTANT NOTICE

CHANGE IN APPROVED BOT MANUFACTURERS

On October 21st, 2005 Arrow Games Corporation acquired all remaining consumables business and certain assets of Bingo Press & Specialty Limited doing business as Bazaar & Novelty in Ontario. This acquisition includes bingo paper and break open tickets (BOT).

Effective October 21st, 2005 a new company called Bazaar & Novelty Limited, a subsidiary of Arrow Games Corporation, was registered as a Break Open Ticket Manufacturer. Bazaar & Novelty Limited will continue to manufacture all break open tickets formerly manufactured by Bingo Press & Specialty doing business as Bazaar & Novelty.

In order to minimize any negative impact that this acquisition may cause to charities, the Registrar has deemed all current licences where the manufacturer of break open tickets is listed as Bingo Press & Specialty or Bazaar & Novelty to include Bazaar & Novelty Limited. Bazaar and Novelty Limited is approved to manufacture all "BN" tickets as listed on the Schedule of Approved Break Open Ticket Types and Associated Expense Maximums (http://www.agco.on.ca/pdf/Non-Forms/4016A_e.pdf).

Licensees may also request an amendment to their licence from the licensing authority if they wish to change to another manufacturer authorized by the Registrar to supply break open tickets in Ontario. The Registrar will not charge a fee for any such amendment

All new licences issued effective October 24, 2005 should indicate the appropriate ticket type and approved ticket manufacturer. A current List of Approved Break Open Ticket Manufacturers is available on the AGCO website (http://www.agco.on.ca/en/c.gaming/c1.4_P_botmanuf.html).
